Are we having chicken?

Where heihei might be used:

On a menu, on a shelf in-store, at the table.

For learners and speakers

He Whakataukī:

He moa kai hau.

The moa feeding on air. The moa walked with its mouth open and was said to subsist on air. Moa is the word used across the Pacific for chicken. (Ngā Pepeha 576)

Synonyms:
