Wait and we'll begin.

Where taihoa might be used:

In everyday conversation, in the provision of services, on the phone.

For learners and speakers

He Whakataukī:

Taihoa ka tae mai tētahi iwi, he iwi kiritea; ko ngā toki, he toki kahakore; ko ngā waka puni, he mea pani ki te ware.
A fair skinned folk will arrive in the future, whose adzes will not have lashing, whose canoes will be covered and smeared with gum; a prophecy about the arrival of white settlers. (Ngā Pepeha 2186)
