For beginners

Sample sentence:

Mutu ana te Kirihimete, ka whakatā te nuinga. After Christmas many people take [their] holidays.

Where whakatā might be used:

On bus timetables, in holiday titles.

For learners and speakers

Whakataukī:

Ki te awatea he kaumātua, ki te pō he tamariki. A mature adult in the daytime but at night a carefree child. About attending to serious concerns in the day and resting at night. (Ngā Pepeha 1356)

Synonyms:

Whakangā, whakamatua, okioki.
